#### Introduction

Connexions Trafford publish Activity Survey Reports for schools to show what activities their school leavers have gone on to do in the first few months after leaving compulsory education. Progression Reports are an extension of this analysis and show what activities school leavers have gone on to do up to 3 years after leaving compulsory education.

Progression Report data is based on a young person's Destination/Activity on the 1st November of each Academic Year after leaving school. This criteria is in line with the Year 11 Leaver Activity Survey Reports which are published annually for schools.

Trafford Connexions are responsible for tracking, following up and reporting on a young person's activity after they leave compulsory education **only** if they are a Trafford resident. Destination/Activity information for non-Trafford residents, which is included within this report, is therefore **not verified** after the Activity Survey data is finalised in the year that a young person leaves school. A figure is given at the bottom of each table to indicate the number of young people in any particular school leaving year who are not resident in Trafford.
